Minutes of Market Weston Parish Council meeting held on Thursday 11th April 2024 7.00pm in Market Weston Village Hall

5. The Green

To discuss options for football goal and works to re-establish the bike mounds and tracks on The Green.

A local resident has offered to do some work on the bike mounds and to install a new goal post, at his own expense, on The Green. In principle the Parish Council are very happy for these works to be undertaken. However, they would require clarification of a number of points first. We would like confirmation of how the works to the bike mounds would be undertaken and what size the finished mounds would be. We would like to maintain grass between the mounds. We need to know the size of the goal and would need to confirm they meet any current safety regulations. A location for the goal was agreed, this would be on the larger grassed area, in line with the two trees, adjacent to the pathway. Cllr Barham will confirm the details with the resident and the Clerk will check any requirements around the goal posts.
